Life Group Questions | Sunday, February 10, 2019

How would you describe your relationship with creation?

Read Job 12:7-10 & Romans 1:20. How do these passages invite you to consider creation? What is your response to this invitation?

Read Romans 8:19-22. What stirs in you as you read this passage? How is it different or similar from how you think about creation and our relationship to it?

The authors of the Bible expected that their readers (us) would share a daily connection to creation. Most of us don't. What might be lost when our connection with creation isn't cultivated? What might be gained when it is cultivated?

Read Matthew 6:26-30. What do you notice about how Jesus talks about creation? Are there other stories that come to mind where Jesus explores the connection between humanity and creation?

Do you have a story to share when God's creation ministered to you? What was that like?

How might you explore your relationship with creation this week? Brainstorm some ideas as a group.

Pray together. Begin by reading **Isaiah 55:8-13.**
