Life Group Questions | Sunday, May 12, 2019

What's your level of interest or engagement with politics? What motivates you to have that posture?

Read Jeremiah 29:4-7. Jeremiah wrote a letter from Jerusalem to the Jewish refugees in Babylon telling them to settle in and be a faithful presence while in exile. What principles can you draw from this passage? How can those principles shine light on our call to be a faithful presence in our day?

Read Psalm 20:7. In what ways do we ask politics to be things or do things they can't be or do? How do you wrestle with that in your own life?

Discuss the following Life Lessons. How do these ideas intersect with your life? What statement most challenges you? Pick one or two areas where you can identify a next step. Share that next step with the group.

1. We should find our identity and hope in Jesus.
2. We should seek power under and not power over.
3. We should focus on what unites instead of what divides.
4. We should listen to people with a different perspective.
5. We should wisely engage the political process.
6. We should be kind.

Pray together. End by praying for our political leaders.
