

THE BIBLE: ENTERING THE STORY

Life Group Questions | Sunday, October 6, 2019

What is one of your favorite stories? What do you love about it?

Read Luke 24:13-35. Imagine yourself as one of the people on the road. What would you have been thinking and feeling as you spoke with (the unrecognized) Jesus? What do you think Jesus was up to?

The message on Sunday highlighted key movements in the biblical story. **Discuss the following movements and scripture passages.** Have you heard the story told this way? What resonates with you? What questions or thoughts does this telling of the story bring out in you?

- **Created in His Image** (Genesis 1:26-28)
- **Cracked Icons** (Romans 1:21-22)
- **True Icon** (Romans 3:21-27)
- **Restored Icons** (Colossians 3:9-17)
- **King Jesus** (Revelation 5:11-14, 22:1-5)
- **Good News** (Mark 1:1, Luke 4:14-21)

Do you see the Bible as a story? How so? How not? Why does that matter?

How does the story of the Bible shape how you see your own story? What would it take for you to enter “the story” in a deeper way? What’s keeping you from jumping in?

Pray together. Close with 2 minutes of silent reflection. Ask God how he might be inviting you to participate in his big, redemptive story.
