

# PHILIPPIANS: THE UNSTOPPABLE GOSPEL

*Life Group Questions | Sunday, April 26, 2020*

Paul's challenge to a different way of life continues, in light of a mighty and unstoppable gospel. He re-orientes our perspectives on suffering, rivalries, and even death.

**Read Philippians 1:12-30** paying special attention to verses 27 through 30.

What stands out to you? What challenges you? Encourages you?

Pastor John provides a succinct and helpful definition of the gospel: "the announcement of God's reign and restoration through King Jesus".

How would you define the gospel, and how does John's explanation compare to yours? Did you find his definition helpful or insightful?

**Discuss the following key ideas:**

- As citizens of God's kingdom we stand together in unity and solidarity.
- As citizens of God's kingdom we live boldly and confidently, knowing that God is reigning.
- As citizens of God's kingdom we see suffering as opportunity.

Practically, how do you see these playing out in your own life? Are you convicted by any of these points, and if so how would you like to adjust or more actively participate?

**Close in prayer.** What keeps you from living more wholeheartedly as a citizen of God's kingdom? Pray for one another, bringing those barriers and sticky places to God.
