Life Group Questions | Sunday, December 17, 2017

Read Matthew 5:43-48. How do you think the original audience would have reacted to Jesus' teaching? What stands out to you?

In this passage, the Greek word translated as love is AGAPE. Agape love is sourced from God. It is a giving, selfless, expect-nothing-in-return type of love. Agape love is an expression of grace. As followers of Jesus, how do we practice this kind of agape love in our most challenging relationships?

Read the passages and discuss these qualities of agape love:

- Romans 5:8—The love of Jesus is proactive.
What does proactive love look like?
- Ephesians 2:14—The love of Jesus has no boundaries.
What does a love free of boundaries look like?
- John 13:34-35—The love of Jesus is personal.
What does it look like to cultivate a love for others that's personal?
