Life Group Questions | Sunday, October 22, 2017

What concepts from the Genesis series have been resonating with you so far?

Read Genesis 2:8-9, 16-17. What is the knowledge of good and evil? Why do you think God commanded Adam and Eve not to eat from that tree?

Read Genesis 3:1-5. In the ancient near east, snakes represented forces of evil—the antithesis of life. What does this passage reveal about the tactics and intentions of evil?

Read Genesis 3:6-7. What was significant about Adam and Eve's choice? What were the consequences? Can you relate to Adam & Eve's circumstance? How so?

Read Genesis 3:8-13. How does Adam and Eve's choice affect the relationships in this story?

Read Genesis 3:14-24. How do you see the curses and consequences named in the text at work in the world? What does this passage reveal about God's disposition towards our brokenness and shame?

Read Colossians 1:13-22. What hope do we have for relationships being made right? How do you see this hope shaping your daily life?
