

MAKING GOD IN OUR OWN IMAGE

Life Group Questions | Sunday, November 19, 2017

What did you want to be when you were growing up?

Read Genesis 11:1-9. What are the people in this story trying to do? What's motivating their efforts? Why did God choose to scatter the people? What from the text leads you to your conclusions?

What's at stake when our image of God is off? When your image of God shrinks, what happens to your image of yourself?

Job endured unthinkable suffering and though he trusted God, he struggled deeply to make sense of his unbearable life circumstances. Read Job 38:1-21 & Job 42:1-6. Why do you think God responds to Job's confusion in this way? What impacts you most from their interaction?

Read Philippians 2:3-11. How does Jesus model the quality of relationship we are meant to have with God, ourselves, and others? What characteristics does this passage highlight?

Is there a relationship in your life that needs a renewed posture of humility from you? What would that look like? What would you need to get there?

Pray together. Consider opening or closing with this simple prayer:

*Holy Spirit, heal our image of God that we may
relate rightly to ourselves, you, and others.*
