*Life Group Questions | Sunday, May 6, 2018*

In your daily life (grocery store, coffee shop, etc.), do you prefer having abundant or limited options? Why do you think that is?

**Read Ephesians 5:15-17.** What does it mean to *live as wise*? Who comes to mind when you think of a wise woman or man in your life? What attributes do they possess?

The key to unlocking a wise and flourishing life is to understand the will of God. What is your understanding of God's will? How does that understanding impact your life and decision making?

Scripture speaks of God's will in two primary ways: God's sovereign will and God's moral will.

**Read the following passages** that explore the sovereign will of God. What key words, themes, and ideas do you see?

**Ephesians 1:11 | Isaiah 46:9-10 | Acts 2:22-24**

**Read the following passages** that explore the moral will of God. What key words, themes, and ideas do you see?

**1 Thessalonians 4:3 & 5:16-18 | Micah 6:8**

According to these passages and your own experiences, how would you describe the distinctions between God's sovereign and moral will?

Is there a difference between believing God has a detailed, uniquely designed plan for each person and believing God cares deeply about our choices and the people we are becoming? In what ways does your belief impact your life?

**Read Proverbs 3:5-8.** How does this passage encourage you?
