Life Group Questions | Sunday, December 16, 2018

Did you have opportunities to wait this week? What were those like?

Read Luke 2:8-20. Try to look at this well-worn scene with new eyes. What do you see? What details or descriptions stand out?

What good news does the angel deliver? How do the shepherds respond?

Recall a time when you received good news about something you had been waiting for. What was it like to process that? How did you respond?

Read Psalm 130:5-6. What do you think it means to wait for the Lord? In what ways do watching and waiting relate to one another?

What are you waiting for? Is watching part of your waiting? How so?

Read Luke 4:18-20. What is the good news described in this passage? How was the good news delivered to you? What words or ideas would you use to describe the good news?

As you are willing, share your story of coming to know and trust in the Good News.

Pray together. Close with Psalm 130:5-6.
