

On Mission: Going Viral

Passage: Acts 16:11-15

Main idea: We all have our own Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria and ends of the earth to which we are witnesses of Jesus.

Purpose: To encourage people to bear witness to Jesus in their day-to-day lives.

Review the Group Guidelines.

Read Acts 16:11-15.

Pastor Mike talked about opportunities to share the Gospel in households, communities, workplaces and the public square.

- **In which of those areas are you most comfortable/likely to bear witness to the Gospel? Why?**
- **In which of those areas are you least comfortable/likely to bear witness to the Gospel? Why?**

Think about your neighborhood and the conversations that go on there. Are they more likely to be gossip-centered or Gospel-centered? Why? How could you re-focus interactions on the Gospel (note: words are not always necessary ...)

Some workplaces present obstacles to Gospel conversations. How else can believers witness there? How can they work around or through the obstacles.

Think about the interview Pastor Mike shared regarding the “Jesus Gets Us” campaign. The interviewer said, “You say you love us. But we don’t feel that love.” How did you react to that? What can you do to change that?

If the best witness happens within relationship, with our words and our actions, and in the context of love, how might that change your interactions with others?

Re-read Acts 16:11-15. Pray about how we all might conduct ourselves “in a manner worthy of the Gospel of Christ.” (Philippians 1:27)
