Life Group Questions | Sunday, May 10, 2020

Did you grow up in a more disciplined or undisciplined household? What comes to mind when you think of “obedience?”

Read Philippians 2:12-18. What stands out to you? Are there certain words or phrases that grab your attention or raise questions in you?

What do you think it means to work out your salvation with fear and trembling? Let's put that phrase in dialogue with **1 John 4:15**. There are tensions we live in when we live a life with God. How do you navigate this particular tension?

Do you have a story to share about a time you were reluctant to obey?

How does the way you understand who God is impact your perspective on obedience? Do you see God as worthy of joyful obedience?

When is obedience hard and what gets in the way?

Read Romans 12:1-2. What does offering yourself to God look like in this particular time in your life?

The choices we make set a trajectory in our life for future choices. What spiritual discipline or practice might you try to implement this week, month, year to grow stronger in the life-giving way of Jesus?
