If you could be any animal, what would you be?

Read Psalm 23. This week we will be focusing on verses 1-2. Is this image of God as Shepherd a compelling image to you? Why or why not? What qualities does this image imply about God?

David (the author of this Psalm) says that he lacks nothing. How does that claim land with you? Do you have all that you need? Have you experienced the kind of contentment David is describing? What gets in the way of contentment in your life?

If God is our Shepherd, then we are God's sheep. Is it challenging for you to surrender to this idea of being a "sheep"? What does it look like to live this way?

How do you desire to grow in your relationship with God, your Shepherd? Is there an area of your life or an issue/circumstance that God might be inviting you to trust God with?
