Review the Group Guidelines.

God became fully vulnerable to be fully known. What does it mean to you to realize God was willing to become vulnerable in order to redeem us and reconnect with us personally?

Read Psalm 139:13-16.

What thoughts or feelings occur for you when reading David's words?

The Bible reveals we are made in God's image. How does God's willingness to display vulnerability change the importance of being vulnerable to you?

From what you know about king David, how do you think vulnerability shaped who he was as a leader and as a man after God's heart? What examples come to mind?

Read John 1:1-3, 14.

Have you observed those in power ever failing to follow the rules/laws they put in place? How does it impact you when you consider how our all-powerful Creator chose to submit to becoming a human?

What does vulnerability look like in your life?

Realizing there are risks in being vulnerable, is there a relationship where you need to be courageous in vulnerability?

What is something you want to continue to reflect on, pray over, change, or begin to practice this week?

Pray together. Close by reading Psalm 139: 1-3 (MSG)
