## **Passage: Luke 19:11-27**

### **Read Luke 19:11-27**

What part of this multi-layered parable is easiest for you to relate to? What part challenges you the most?

Review and share your reflections on the three questions that Pastor Mike asked on Sunday:

1. What does it look like for Jesus to be king in your life?
2. What do we need to be faithful with while Jesus is away?
3. What does the kingdom of God look like?

Eugene Peterson wrote: *“He intends us to get involved, our feet in the mud and our hands in the bread dough, with the living God who is at work in this world . . . to get us actively in on the ways and will of God in the homes and neighborhoods and workplaces where we spend our time.”* How can we bring the kingdom into those areas of our lives?

What does it look like for you to faithfully do the work of the King until He returns? What might you have to change or increase or even stop doing to more fully participate in the Kingdom that is both “now and not yet?”

**Re-read Luke 19:11-27.** Pray about exploring ways to become even more faithful to the kingdom work of God.
