Life Group Questions | Sunday, August 16, 2020

What would be your first purchase if you won the lottery?

Read Proverbs 30:7-9. Do you relate to these requests? How so? What does “daily bread” living mean to you?

Discuss the following lies about money. Read the corresponding scripture passages. What falsehood are you most vulnerable to?

- **Money is evil.**
 - Biblically money is neither good or bad. What the sages and other writers of Scripture warn us against is the love of money (1 Timothy 6:10, Matthew 6:21).
- **Money will make us secure.**
 - We are created and redeemed to find our security in God. (Proverbs 23:4-5).
- **We never have enough.** What God provides is enough. God promises to take care of us (Matthew 6:26, 1 Timothy 6:6-9).

How would you describe your relationship with money? Is generosity challenging for you? How so, or why not? Do you have a story to share about God’s faithfulness to provide?

Pray together. Take a moment of silent reflection. Ask God to lead you in one act of unprovoked generosity this week. **Close by reading 2 Corinthians 8:9.**
