

RESURRECTING CHURCH: AN EYE-OPENING PRAYER

Life Group Questions | Sunday, May 2, 2021

What key idea captured your attention this morning? What about that was compelling or meaningful to you?

Read Ephesians 1:15-23. One of Paul's chief aims in Ephesians 1 is to get those of us who are part of the church to see ourselves from a new perspective. This is the essential key to being properly equipped to live out the story. What gets in the way of seeing yourself the way God sees you? What changes when you do?

A primary way the church can be the church to one another is to remind each other how God sees us. In what ways do you do this well? How might you grow in this practice?

Do you have a story to share about someone reminding you how God sees you? How did that experience impact you?

What questions or wonderings did the message prompt in you today?

What is something you want to continue to reflect on, pray over, or practice (live out) this week?

Pray together. Take a few moments to consider who are the people in your life that remind you of who you are in Christ. Thank God for those individuals. Ask God to if there is someone you can help remind of their identity in Christ this week.
