Life Group Questions | Sunday, May 9, 2021

Read Ephesians 2:1-10. What words or phrases stand out to you? What questions do you have?

God's remedy for our human plight—God's response to a humanity enslaved in a prison of performance—is **grace**. How does this concept sit with you? What questions, "what-ifs," or "yeah, buts" does it evoke in you?

What is grace?

Do you have a story to share about God's grace in your life?

What does the "prison of performance" look like in your life?

Read Titus 2:11-14. Grace is not only our hope for our past, grace is our hope for our present and our future. Grace empowers us to participate in God's good work. How do you understand or wrestle with the paradox?

What is something you want to continue to reflect on, pray over, or practice (live out) this week?

Pray together. Begin with a practice of gratitude, naming specific graces from this past week.
