THE LORD'S PRAYER: DELIVERANCE FROM EVIL

Life Group Questions | Sunday, January 24, 2021

Read Matthew 6:9-13. This week we are focusing on verse 13.

As we talk about the presence of evil in our world, have a conversation as a group—where are you coming from as you engage this topic? What experiences or teachings shape your views?

Read James 1:13 & Matthew 4:1. God allows us to experience temptation but God is not the originator of temptation. What questions or reflections do you have about this?

Read Matthew 26:41. Every day we face temptation from the Evil One. When we pray the Lord's prayer, we are praying for rescue. We are praying for the strength of God to allow us to not fall into temptation. Where do you desire and need the strength of God's deliverance?

Read Romans 7:21-23. What does this passage stir in you? How do you relate or not relate?

Read Ephesians 6:12. When we minimize or ignore the Evil One, we do so at our own peril. How might God be inviting you live and think in light of this reality this week?

When we pray "deliver us from the Evil One" we can pray in confidence because in essence, Jesus already has. Jesus has been victorious. We say "yes" to God's strength, not striving in our own. Take a moment to reflect on an area of life that you need the victory and freedom of Jesus. As you are willing, share with one another and pray for one another.
