*Life Group Questions | Sunday, January 31, 2021*

## **Read Matthew 6:9-13.**

What has been most meaningful to you as we have spent the last month reflecting on the Lord's prayer?

Do you lean toward extemporaneous prayer (praying with your own words) or using written prayers? What has been your experience with both?

**Read Luke 11:2-4.** Luke's gospel also has a version of the Lord's Prayer. What do you notice about the similarities and differences between Luke and Matthew's version?

Wesley Hill talked about prayer as rebellion, rebelling against the broken ways of the world and praying for God's intervention. What do you think of that idea?

The Lord's prayer is about turning our gaze and attention to God. When you are struggling or stressed, what are the first things you turn to?

What beliefs, actions, or attitudes get in the way of your turning toward God? What might it look like for you to remember to turn to God this week?

**Pray together.** Close by reading (or reciting) the Lord's Prayer together.
