Life Group Questions | Sunday, October 18, 2020

Do you have a story to share about a time when you felt deeply listened to? What impact did that experience have on you?

Read James 1:19-25. How does this passage talk about listening? What else stands out to you? What questions do you have?

What makes a good listener? Would you describe yourself as one? Do you find it hard to listen well? As a group, talk about what gets in the way of good listening.

What does listening have to do with following Jesus?

Read Exodus 3:4-10. This is just one example of God listening to God's people, of being moved to compassion by their cries. Do you think of God as a good listener? How so or how not?

Our invitation for this week is to practice low-stakes listening. What will that look like for you this week?

Pray together. Close by reading Psalm 10:16-18.
