Life Group Questions | Sunday, June 21, 2020

How would your friend or spouse describe your waiting-in-line behavior?

Read Genesis 40:1-41:1. As you read, use your senses to imagine the story. Talk about the various characters and their emotions/reactions. What details stand out to you? What do you think the narrator was trying to communicate?

Read Genesis 41:1-14, 39-43. Talk about this “comeback story.” What stands out to you about Joseph’s story of waiting? What challenges you? What gives you hope?

Discuss the following Life Lessons. What resonates with you? Challenges you? What questions do you have? What stories can you share from your own life?

- **Waiting is not wasted time. It is sacred space.** (Psalm 130:5-8).
- **While we wait God is at work in us.** (Psalm 46:10)
- **We are not meant to wait passively.** (Lamentations 3:22-24)

What waiting rooms are you in today? How might these statements shape your perspective?
