

YOU'LL GET THROUGH THIS: A GOOD STORY

Life Group Questions | Sunday, July 5, 2020

Share a story about being lost. Did you ask for directions? How did you find your way?

Read Genesis 50:12-21. As you read, use your senses to imagine the story. Talk about the various characters and their emotions/reactions. What details stand out to you? What do you think the narrator was trying to communicate?

Read Genesis 46:3-4. Throughout Genesis 45-50, we see how God oriented Jacob to God's story, Jacob oriented Joseph to God's story, and now Joseph with his brothers who are wrapped up in their own stories of fear and what-if and reorients them to God's story, too. How do you understand God's good story? What hope does that story give you?

Discuss the following Life Lessons.

- **Recognize our false stories.**
 - What stories are you "making up" today? Stories that feel complete even if they aren't accurate.
- **Reorient to God's good story.**
 - What are the 1 or 2 "must do" daily practices that keep you oriented to who you are and God's good story?
- **Trust God with your story.**
 - What part of your story hasn't found its way into God's redemptive hands? What would it look like to let God's light shine in?
